Cost of trust – key themes

- Defining trust.
- Economic significance of trust.
- Cost of upholding trust.
- Pilot analysis of estimating cost of trust for U.S. economy.
 - Weighting employment-by-occupation by time spent/marginal product on trust-intensive work roles.
 - 35% of U.S. employment-by-occupation involved in trust-intensive activity.
 - e.g. managers, lawyers, accountants, tax agents, etc.
- Cost of trust alternative estimating approaches.
- Implication of blockchain for cost of trust.
 - Disruption of existing trust-intensive work roles (Schumpeterian mechanism).
 - Reallocation of tasks within existing trust-intensive work roles (Kirznerian mechanism).
